**TERRITORY (altitude)** - The territory of **Rofrano** covers about 59 sq km and an altitude that ranges from 110 meters above sea level of the Sea (the lowest point), and 1,521 meters above sea level (point higher). The center is located Rofrano am 467 above sea level, while the frazione **Menale St.**, 2.49 km far from the center, is 455 meters above sea level

**TERRITORY** - **Rofrano** is crossed by several rivers and streams, in particular from **Pharaoh**, which bathes the western part and the **Carcil** that it wets the southern part. The Pharaoh was born Rofrano on Fri-tere and receives along its water from numerous streams and springs. Released from the territory of Rofrano, Pharaoh takes the name of **Mingardo** (Formerly known as Menicardo and before Molpa) taking a journey 37km of which ends in the Gulf of Palinuro. These waterways past, were used for irrigation, tanneries, mills, oil mills and the ironworks that there was one in Rofrano and the other to Alfano.

In 1996, the **prof. Maximum Crest**, an anthropologist and professor of Ecology-Human already at the University "La Sapienza" of Rome, was conferred honorary citizenship of Rofrano, for the studies on local community, conducted over four decades and landed work *"Study of the pattern of feeding behavior in Mediterranean diet in relation to population biology: Ro-landslide, 1954-1994, a paradigmatic case."* In 1954, prof. Crest had coordinated the first study on the patterns of life and eating habits of the population of Rofrano, making a series of measurements, repeats then at a distance, once a "generational".

In 1954, the National Institute of Nutrition, with the participation of various institutions, including the Department of Anthropology at the University "La Sapienza" of Rome, he performed in Rofrano, a large study aimed to investigate the relationship between diet and health status of the population. The results served to put a precise point on the scientific knowledge concerning the relationship between biological condition and nutritional status of populations living in poor areas of Noon. In 1980 and 1999, the measurements were repeated, always with the scientific coordination of prof. Ridge, with the outcome of give the investigation a considerable authority.

**MADONNA DI GROTTAFERRATA** The icon of the Madonna na Grottaferrata, attested in 1583 in the Church and then disappeared, have followed two statues. One of them, brick and lime, is placed in the chancel of the sanctuary. The other, of wood, sculpted in Naples around 1850 by Francis Xavier Citarelli, is carried in procession on the occasion of the festival eight in September. To want this statue were the brother priests **Ronsini**: Don Michelangelo, Archpriest of Rofrano, and the Canon Domenicantonio, the latter deserving local historian. Copies of the statue of Our Lady of Grottaferrata are present in Australia, at the community of emigrants Rofranesi.

**HISTORY**In the XI-XII century, the Monastery of the Basilian, located in the Land of **Rofrano**, was the object of the concession made by the King of Sicily Abbot Leander, making Diocesan island of Basilian Abbey Grottaferrata. In 1490, the feudal lord **Giovanni Carafa** usurped the legal ecclesiastical tribunal, driving from Rofrano Monks. So writes the Ronsini: "The Basilian alienated the estate, had remained in the Convent pel Spiritual government of the place. But the Carafa taken malmenarli for all the streets, and finally forced to sloggiarne. (...) Fissaron the seat in Grange near Montesano, whence vegliavan on the remaining Grandcie ...".

**ORIGINS AND CHRISTIANITY** As early as 400 AD, the area that goes by Laurin in Rofrano was at the forefront of Christianity. In that and little rose the voice and example of **S. Elina** (called St. Helena) by Laurino, who consecrated herself to God's love, penance of a cave in "Plum", near Rofrano Vetere, not far from a Monastery of Basilian monks, suffered and prayed for sinners, until the day of death. The abbot of that Cenobio offered some food to Santa, who retribuiva sewing or mending the habits of monks. He died in his cave, in the territory of Rofrano Vetere, the body was then placed in the church of Laurino, his homeland.

**HISTORY: THE CHURCH OF ST MARY GROTTAFERRATA -**

Traditionally, it is believed that the relics are existing in Rofrano were moved from the East by the Basilian monks, recovered in time of persecution, survived the destruction. Heretics, in sec. VIII - IX, vied to recover relics and cast into the fire, with the bones of the cunning criminals and so did not could distinguish the ashes of the saints. Coming from these sources amounted an inscription inside the crypt of Santa Maria di Grottaferrata.

The Apostolic Commissioner, in 1583, describes the little decent and invites the Mayor and elected representatives to adjudicate. In 1867 he lost the title of S. Sofia, retaining only that of S. **JEROME AND THE CAPECE palzzo AUESPERG** At the loss of the estate of Rofrano in 1682, Jerome Capece and son Peter retained the title of Marquis of Rofrano. With this honor, sided with the Habsburgs, emerged victorious in the war of succession Spanish, managed to make his mark in Vienna. The first, com-Auesperg sender of the Palace, the environment of the "Knight of the Rose" Strauss, whose own theatrical work in the second, Peter (as Ottaviano de Rofrano), rises to the role of the protagonist.

The streets were narrow and difficult for frequent steps across cobblestone and always crowded with herds of pigs. At the village there were three public fountains but no perennial source.

**CHURCH OF ST MARY GROTTAFERRATA** Inside the Sanctuary of St. Mary of Grottaferrata have to admire the bust wooden S. Elijah the seventeenth century. A wooden statue of St. Rocco seventeenth sec., a reproduction of the icon of Our Lady of Grottaferrata table-installment, donated in 2008 dall'Archimandrita tuscolana of the Abbey, Father E. Manufacturer. The wooden statue of the Virgin Mary of Grottaferrata, more recent invoice, dates from the mid-nineteenth century, and is the work of sculptor Neapolitan Citarelli. Another statue of the Madonna, in masonry, is placed in the niche of the chancel and could date back to the thirteenth century.

#### HISTORY: THE CHURCH OF ST MARY GROTTAFERRATA

A description of the **Church of St. Mary of Grottaferrata** is derived from the report made by the Pastoral Visit of the Holy Commissioner Apostolic Silvio Galasso, April 18, 1583: "The Clergy, the Sin-Elected mayor and the University of Rofrano receive the Commissioner Apostolic, which is accompanied in procession to the parish matrix of the Blessed Mary of Grottaferrata. " From this place we know that the Church of St. Mary Parish and was cared for 700 souls scattered in 200 families.

**URBAN PLANNING** - The old town of **Rofrano** conserves the urban structure of the original network of streets and stairs that create a complex system of connections that distribute to the various buildings levels. Once it was all walled and surrounded by **three towers and three gates** (**Porta S. Antuono** east, south and west **door Vallone's Gate** Holm oak).

At the same time it is formed the *Consorzio* of producers Oil bulls, which established a rigid discipline of production, with the identification of the origin and processing of olives, included in 62 municipalities, all included in the National Park and all characterized by the presence of ancient olive trees, which represent one of the dominant elements of the landscape.
